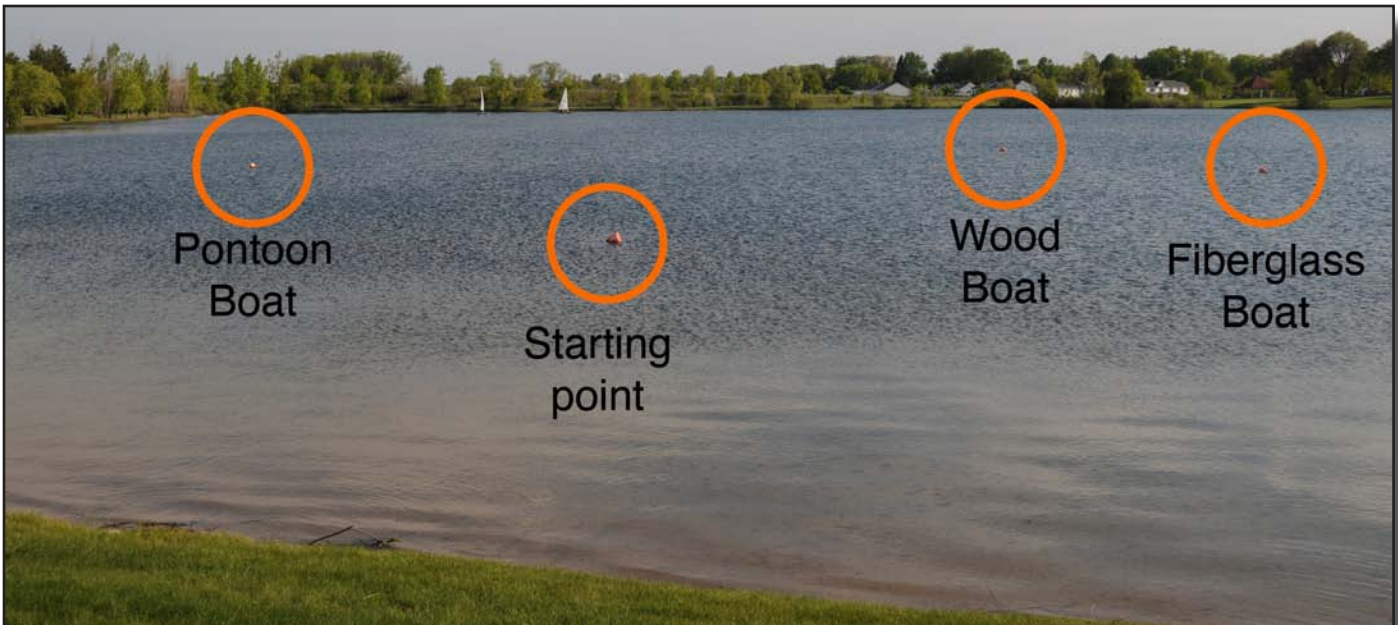

Guide to Underwater Boats



The Saginaw County Sheriff Department Dive Team sank three boats in the park for scuba divers.

The starting point is lined up between the sign and the pavilion on the opposite shore. A rope is fixed to an anchor and an underwater buoy. There are NO surface buoys. These just show the relative position of the boats.



From the starting point a rope leads to the pontoon boat. Ropes lead from the pontoon boat to the other boats, which are also connected together. The boats lie in about 18 feet of water. The total swim, from the starting point to all three boats and back to the starting point is about 600 feet. It is easy to kick up the bottom. There are usually many fish in the weeds and around the boats.
